Our landscaping department will be expanding its scope of operation by doing more brick and rock work. We will continue to do design, construction and maintenance of new and existing home landscapes.

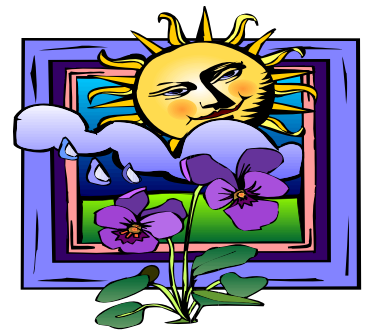
